GOVERNMENT RELATIONS



Government Relations Committee

The Government Relations Committee helps identify and advise SIA members regarding legislation, regulations and other policy trends or pending government actions affecting the security industry and makes high-level recommendations for related actions.

Accomplishments:

- Providing guidance and representation of SIA members and their interests before federal and state lawmakers, as well as drafting comments on regulations and agency proceedings on polices affecting the security industry
- **Publications and Tools:** Provides resources such as the SIA Federal Grants Guide, Guide to School Security Funding, Guide to U.S. Biometric Privacy Laws, Guide to Cannabis Security Requirements, Guide to Facial Recognition Laws
- **Tax Reform:** Helped secure key incentives for businesses to purchase fire and security systems in the tax overhaul signed into law in 2025 (P.L. 119-21).
- **Procurement Policy:** Enactment of the “Local Preparedness Acquisition Act” legislation authored by SIA, which extended General Services Administration (GSA) Cooperative Purchasing to Schedule 84 (security products) under the Federal Supply Schedules program, allowing state and local governments to make purchases through the program.
- **School Security:** Secured key provisions in the Stop School Violence Act of 2018 and supported increases to these programs that were included in the Bipartisan Safer Communities Act
- **Regulatory Relief:** Enactment of the Power and Security Systems Act in 2017 which culminated a yearlong effort to preserve an important exemption from federal energy efficiency rules critical to the operation of security and fire alarm systems
- **State Policy:** Secured exemptions for sensitive security and life safety equipment from right-to-repair laws in New York and California, and overturned a ban on law enforcement use of facial recognition software in Virginia, replacing it with a regulatory framework ensuring responsible use of this technology
- **Political Engagement:** Formed the influential Security PAC political action committee

GOVERNMENT RELATIONS



Identity and Biometric Technology Advisory Board

The SIA Identity and Biometric Technology Advisory Board (IBTAB) is an exclusive advisory panel to the SIA Board of Directors. IBTAB is comprised of biometric and digital identification experts who guide SIA's engagement with operators of critical infrastructure in both private and public sectors. IBTAB's technical expertise focuses on the operational and scalable features embedded within advanced biometric and digital identification solutions, and IBTAB members are prepared to work with policymakers and decision makers interested in understanding such solutions.

Drone Security Subcommittee

The SIA Drone Security Subcommittee (originally the Counter-UAS Working Group) was created in 2023 to further educate on available counter-UAS technologies and appropriate training, and give authorities options to mitigate UAS attacks. After years of advocating for legislation to address the rising threats to public safety and infrastructure posed by the misuse of drones, the Subcommittee is eager to support the implementation of the SAFER SKIES Act, which was approved by Congress in December 2025. The group also supports executive branch recommendations such as the Domestic Counter-UAS National Action Plan and the executive order on Restoring American Airspace Sovereignty. This group of technology providers, end users and subject matter experts collaborates with external organizations aligned with those goals; tracks and monitors supportive legislation; and identifies, educates and engages with legislators.

- Led presentations at SIA GovSummit and the ISC Security Events conferences
- Authored a series of articles on important drone and counter-UAS topics
- Communicated support for S. 1631, the Safeguarding the Homeland From the Threats Posed by Unmanned Aircraft Systems Act
